

BTEC Technical Award in Digital Information Technology

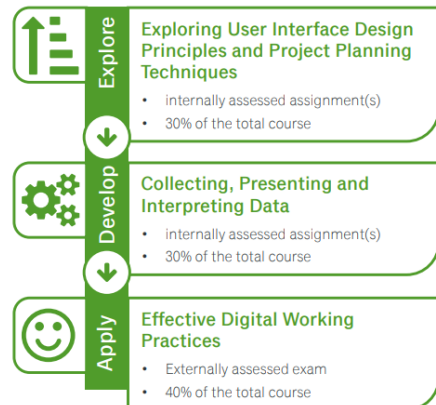


Why choose a qualification in ICT? The vast majority of jobs require people to have some degree of IT skills. Digital IT prepares you to plan projects, solve problems, as well as, gaining practical skills in spreadsheet, word processing, and presentation software.

What will I study?

There are 3 components:

1. Looks at interface design as well as project planning
2. Collecting, presenting and interpreting data
3. Effective Digital working



Who would this course suit?

- A stepping stone to careers like IT Project Management, Technical Support and Cyber Security.
- Great for hands-on learners who want to get straight in and 'make'.

How will I learn?



This course is varied and allows you to develop a range of skills (not just software). You will therefore be engaged in :-

- Practical skills

How will my work be assessed?

You will have:

- Regular homework
- Assessments – at the end of each unit
- Mini tests – check your understanding as you go along
- Practical work.
