



Dear parents and carers of Year 7,

I would like to confirm the arrangements for the forthcoming residential retreat to Alton Castle. Your child has been allocated group 2. Students in group 2 will attend Alton Castle from Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September – Friday 24<sup>th</sup> September with a trip to Alton Towers included on Friday.

Students in group 2 will attend school as normal on the morning of Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept and will leave school at 1.30pm to travel to Alton castle by coach. Students in group 2 will have an early lunch so all students will have all eaten before leaving school site. Students in group 2 can wear their own clothes on this day.

Students will need to bring the following items with them:

- Sleeping bag and pyjamas
- Personal toiletries (including toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, etc.)
- Spending money for tuck shop whilst at Alton Castle + spending money for Alton Towers
- T-shirts
- Underwear
- 3 pairs of loose-fitting trousers (leggings or joggers)
- 2 warm long-sleeved jumpers
- 1 waterproof coat
- 2 pairs of walking socks, pair of wellies or walking boots (there are some wellies available to borrow if necessary)
- 1 pair of old trainers (to be worn outside - they will get muddy)
- 1 pair of indoor shoes (trainers are ideal)
- Water bottle
- Torch (optional)

Students are permitted to bring a mobile phone but neither the school nor Alton castle can accept any responsibility for loss or damage. All meals are provided at Alton Castle for the duration of the retreat but your child is welcome to bring additional snacks.

On Friday 24<sup>th</sup> September, students will leave Alton Castle after breakfast to travel to Alton Towers by coach. A packed lunch will be provided by Alton Castle for this day.

Students will be picked up from Alton Towers at 4.30pm with an arrival time back at St Thomas More for approximately 6pm. Your child will update you with our expected arrival time on the day should we encounter any traffic.
